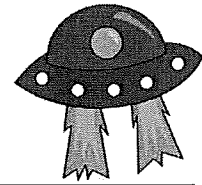

DISMISSAL & PICK-UP ----- LATE PICK-UP FEES

We understand that sometimes - extenuating circumstances prohibit a parent from picking up a child on time. However, we are also concerned with fairness to our staff members; **children need to be picked by 3:00 each day (extended day: by 5:30)**. With this in mind, the following DAILY LATE PICK-UP FEES will be charged:

<u>Regular</u>	<u>Extended Day</u>	
3:00p – 3:05p	5:30p-5:35p	NO CHARGE
3:06p – 3:15p	5:36p-5:40p	\$5 per car
3:16p – 3:20p	5:41p-5:45p	\$10 per car
3:21p – 3:25p	5:46p-5:50p	\$15 per car
3:26p – 3:30p	5:51p-6:00p	\$20 per car
3:31p and later	6:01p and later	\$30 + \$1/min. thereafter per car

1st incident: Fees will be charged after 15 minutes; must be paid before child is permitted to return to the site.

2nd incident: Fees charged as published must be paid before child is permitted to return to the site.

3rd incident: Child is dismissed from the program with no refund of registration or swimming fees.

UDP&R Policy Regarding Possession and Personal Use of Individual Entertainment and Communication Electronics During Township Programs and/or at Township Sites by UDP&R Participants

Upper Dublin Township assumes **NO RESPONSIBILITY** for the safety and/or security of individual entertainment and communication electronics brought to programs, trips, activities or events or onto Township sites or property.

- Participants are strongly encouraged to leave specified devices at home.
- If use is deemed problematic, Supervisors retain the right to direct participants to discontinue use of individual entertainment and communication electronic devices.

Additional clarifications:

- ALL UDP&R ACTIVITIES:** UDP&R recognizes that some participants will have **cell phones** so that they can communicate with parents/guardians/family members when traveling to/from sites. Use of cell phones DURING PROGRAMS and WHILE ON SITE by minor participants is permitted as long as the participant asks permission of the Supervisor in charge and the conversation takes place in the Supervisor's presence.
- TRIPS:**
 - Participants may use individual entertainment devices as long as they are using personal headphones or "earbuds" so that the audio cannot be heard by or disturb others in close proximity.
 - Camera use is limited to time outside the vehicle.

Violation:

- Violation of any portion of this policy will result in UDP&R's usual and customary disciplinary procedures going into effect immediately.
- Parent/Guardian of program participant will be notified at the discretion of the supervisor.

Other Things to Note:

- If your child is swimming, please send them to camp in their suit and with a change of clothes.
- Your child should wear tennis shoes to camp everyday. They can bring flip flops to the pool.
- We recommend your child have a water bottle with them everyday with their name on it.
- You are welcome to send snacks with your child.
- Please put **sunscreen** on your child each day and we recommend you send extra with them.
- If your child rides a bike or scooter, they **MUST** wear a helmet. No exceptions.
