

Upper Dublin Township Recreation Scholarship Guidelines

Through the Upper Dublin Township Recreation Scholarship, there are financial assistance services available for qualifying Upper Dublin Township families' children, hereafter to be referred to as Participant. Financial assistance is available for programs offered by the following organizations:

- Upper Dublin Parks & Recreation (UDP&R) - programs
- Upper Dublin Junior Athletic Association (UDJAA) - baseball, softball, cheerleading, field hockey, basketball
- Upper Dublin Youth Football (UDYFC) - football
- Upper Dublin Soccer Club (UDSC) - recreational soccer
- Upper Dublin Aquatic Club (UDAC) - swimming, diving and water polo
- Upper Dublin Lacrosse Club for Boys (UDLC-B) - boys lacrosse
- Upper Dublin Lacrosse Club for Girls (UDLC-G) - girls lacrosse

Terms:

- Financial Assistance will only be given to those Participants that reside in Upper Dublin Township.
- Anyone facing a temporary hardship may qualify for funding. Please complete the Scholarship application and contact Tammy Echevarria at 215-643-1600 x3241 or techevarria@upperdublin.net for details.
- Applications will be available from the Parks & Recreation Department online and at the UDP&R office year-round. Applications will be processed on a first come, first served basis. Applications will be accepted until the Scholarship Funds are exhausted.
- Applicants must provide their letter of approval for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program, which is issued by Upper Dublin School District. The amount of assistance that will be provided to the Participant will be determined by this letter.
- All applications will be processed by the Director and Assistant Director of Parks & Recreation. After processing, you will receive instructions on how to register for the desired programs.
- Each organization manages its own scholarship fund so the maximum amount an individual or household may receive will vary from an organization to organization.

- **For UDP&R programs only:** Completed program registrations must be mailed-in or brought to the Upper Dublin Township Building (370 Commerce Drive, Fort Washington) and accompanied by a **completed program registration form**. Online registration is not available for this type of registration. Participants qualifying for the **Reduced Lunch Program** are required to **pay 15%** of the program's total fee. Participants qualifying for the **Free Lunch Program** are required to **pay 5%** of the program's total fee. Payment is due at the time of registration. All additional program-related fees are the sole responsibility of the Participant. The amount a participant can receive is based on need, available funds and programs fees.
