Although bench donations are no longer accepted at Mondauk Common, many other parks within the township’s 45-park system can support Memorial & Commemorative Benches. Please consider making a bench donation to a site such as Veterans Memorial Park, Robbins Park, East Oreland Park, Klosterman Park, Mondauk Waters (Wentz Pond), North Hills Park, Henry Lee Willet Park, E.B. Wright Park, Twining Valley Park or either of our dog parks. Upper Dublin Township reserves the right to limit the number of benches at any one site.

Standard Design: 6' recycled lumber bench with back
tan lumber with bronze in-ground legs



Donation Amount: \$1200

Donate a new bench and assist the township in selecting a proper location for it. A memorial plaque may be purchased separately by the donor. It will be installed (as shown) by township staff. Your donation of a memorial bench to the Upper Dublin Park system guarantees that the donated bench will remain, with the provided plaque (if applicable), for 25 years beginning the day after its installation.



Plaques are purchased by the donor at an additional cost. Upper Dublin Township must approve the wording that will appear on plaques. Plaques may contain text and dates/numbers only; no photos or graphics.

Color: Brown pebble finish with bronze outline & raised letters

Dimensions: 8" High x 12" Wide x 3/8"-1/2" Deep

In order to initiate your request, please complete the *Memorial & Commemorative Bench Application*. After reviewing your request, you will be contacted to alert you of the request being approved or not approved. If approved, we will set up a meeting at the site to agree upon a specific location.

Once the specific location is agreed upon, a credit card payment or receipt of a check made payable to "Upper Dublin Township" in the full amount of the item is required to secure your donation.
